Since we are not able to hold our December Holiday Gathering Dinner event as we did last year, your directors voted unanimously to redirect the funding for that event to local non-profits. These are Baskervill Food Pantry, St. Frances Animal Center and All 4 Paws. All these local non-profit organizations fill a vital need in our community and, especially this year, are in need of contributions.
